

Tour a Living Cave! Experience a stunning limestone cave in southeastern Arizona with world-class features! This "live" cave, discovered in 1974, is host to a wide variety of formations that were created over **100,000** years, including stalactites, stalagmites, and logic-defying hylactites! Tour guides will unveil this fascinating underground landscape during one of three memorable tours — with an hour underground!

The Discovery Center features museum exhibits, a gift shop, lockers, picnic areas, a hummingbird garden and the Bat Cave Café. The 20-minute First Day Journey video plays daily in the theater. Above ground, you can enjoy camping, hiking trails, Star Parties or CaveFest — our annual cave stewardship celebration!

Cave tours daily (except one week in Sept. for maintenance & Dec. 25, Christmas Day).

No items (phones, bags, purses, packs, water, cameras, etc) are allowed on cave tours; lockers are available for storage.

Rotunda/Throne Tour

Length $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Time $\frac{1}{2}$ hrs. Discover the role that water plays in creating the caverns. See the discoverers' original trail, 45,000-year-old bat guano, delicate formations and "Kubla Khan," the largest column formation in Arizona.

Big Room Tour (available Oct. 15 - Apr. 15)

Length $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Time $\frac{1}{3}$ hrs. The Kartchner Caverns story is about amazing discoveries. Marvel at many strange and colorful cave formations and learn about living and ancient cave fauna. Not available for children under 7 years of age.

Helmet & Headlamp Tour

Length ½ mile. Time 1¼ hrs. Experience the cave as the discoverers did in 1974 using only the light provided by the headlamp on your helmet! Tours are available year-round. From Oct. – April tour is in Big Room, remainder of year in Rotunda/Throne Room. Helmet and Headlamp Tours run on **Saturdays only**. Not available for children under 10 years of age.



Please arrive AT LEAST 1 hour before your scheduled tour time.

The cave has an average temperature of 72° Fahrenheit (22° Celsius) & 99% humidity year-round.
