 **Art Around Town** – We hope to stimulate a greater awareness and appreciation of the arts throughout the community by exhibiting art works which cover a wide range of media. SPRAC members are eligible to participate in exhibitions and sales of their art and photography at a number of locations. We currently have work on exhibit at Cochise College Benson Center, Benson Hospital and Endeavor Gallery. Follow us on Facebook under San Pedro River Arts Council.


 **Artists Share Program** – a monthly opportunity for all visual artists to network and benefit from a free lecture or demonstration presented by guest artists.


 **Celebrate the Arts** – the Arts Council hosts two annual exhibits a year to showcase artists in the community. An open, judged Fine Arts Show and Sale is held each March and an open, judged Photography Show and Sale is presented each October. Cash prizes and ribbons are awarded at both events. Other art-related exhibits and activities such as member's only exhibitions and receptions are held throughout the year.





 **Endeavor Gallery & Gift Shop** – members are eligible to participate in twice yearly, 6 month exhibits in the gallery. Participation in the gift shop is an on-going opportunity with new items coming in throughout the year.
