

- In January 2022, The CED Board allocated **\$173,000** of grant funding to local San Juan County Businesses from the Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity Rural Grant Funding.
- 50 applications received requesting \$1,1696,112 in grant funding.
- Twelve businesses throughout San Juan County were allocated grant funding totaling \$178,000.
- Out of that same Rural Grant Fund, two high school students were allocated \$1500
 each toward furthering their education. One student from Monument Valley and one
 from White Mesa.

According to the Utah Department of Workforce Services

- The long-term trajectory of job levels in San Juan County remains relatively flat, with a slight variation over the last 15 years
- The largest employment sector of the San Juan County economy is the government which provides 40% of total employment in the county.
- Taxable sales for the second quarter of 2022 were up nearly 30.1% over the second quarter of 2021. This is the most considerable year-over change in San Juan County's taxable sales since the fourth quarter of 2018.
