

Frequently Asked Questions for the COVID 19 incentive grant

What if the discounts we offer go over \$5,000, before the deadline date?

- Please keep close track of all the incentives you give out. You will only be reimbursed up to the amount you were awarded.

What if I did not spend all the money given to me, by the deadline date?

- All CARES Acts need to be spent by November 30. If you are getting close to that deadline and will not use all the money for consumer incentives, you may purchase PPE for your business. You will need to submit receipts as proof of PPE purchase.

Is there a deadline when the form needs to be received?

- This is a first come first served grant. We will award as many grants as we have money for. Apply early to get qualified.

What if I do not have a 2019 – 2020 P&L to show because I opened in 2020?

- Please provide a letter of hardship with any appropriate documentation that would show proof of the hardship.

Do I have to prove each discounted transaction and if so how?

- Please use the provided Business Incentive Tracking sheet to keep track of the date and time of the transaction as proof.

How often will I receive more funds?

- Checks will be written once a month in September, October, and November. To receive timely reimbursement please submit your tracking sheet on or before the following dates:
 - September 24
 - October 22
 - November 19

Is there a deadline date for the discount/incentive that I offer?

- It is up to the businesses to provide a compelling incentive to your business. It is up to you to determine dates and expiration.

If I offer a discount after the deadline date, do I still have a chance to receive more money?

- All reimbursements must be in by November 19. Deals or discounts or PPE purchased after that date may not be eligible for reimbursement.

If I apply for this grant can I apply for any other grants that you offer?

- Receiving the Shop in Heber Valley grant does not exclude you from applying for or receiving any other grants offered by Wasatch County CARES Funds.

When will I have to have my discount available?

- As soon as you have received word of approval you may begin offering your deal or discount.
